

Children and Young People Policy

As a community run pub, we are delighted to welcome families to the Rising Sun. In order to maintain a safe and enjoyable environment for all we ask that the following rules are adhered to:

- Children under 16 must be accompanied in the pub and the pub garden at all times and not allowed to be inside or outside unsupervised.
- There is often hot food and drink coming out of the service areas and to avoid any accidents we ask you not to allow children to run around inside the pub.
- Please pay particular attention to small children when our woodburner is lit.
- In our pub garden, please do not allow children to climb on the walls or tables and only adults should operate the parasols on the tables.
- Please do not be offended if our staff remind you to adhere to these rules and failure to follow them may result in you being asked to leave. Please understand that as a licensed premises there are Health and Safety laws and licensing laws that must be adhered to.

We have a selection of Board games available for use and are always happy to supply crayons and paper for your children.

We have high-chairs and gender-neutral baby change facilities and a dedicated children's menu.

If you have any safeguarding concerns about a child when visiting the pub, please speak to a member of staff confidentially about this, who will then share this with our designated safeguarding lead.

Dog Policy

Here at the Rising Sun Community pub, we are super dog friendly. Dogs are welcome both outside in the garden and inside in the pub.

In order to maintain a safe and enjoyable environment for all we ask that the following rules are adhered to:

- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times which is either held by their owner or tied to a solid object.
- Dogs should not be left unattended inside or outside
- Dogs that are causing a disturbance, e.g excessive barking should be taken outside so as to not trouble other customers.
- Any dog excrement should be bagged and disposed of by the owner.
- Please remember to carefully wash your hands before eating or drinking after attending to your dog.
- Please do not be offended if our staff remind you to adhere to these rules and failure to follow them may result in you being asked to leave. Please understand that as a licensed premises there are Health and Safety laws and licensing laws that must be adhered to.
